## South Africa - Lifting of Force majeure and terminal update

Transnet Port Terminals (TPT) has lifted the force majeure declared at the container terminals in the ports of Cape Town, Durban, Ngqura and Port Elizabeth following the cyber-attack of Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2021. The change is effective from 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2021 however, berthing delays are expected to continue in South Africa until such time that all port systems are fully functioning.

TPT have confirmed that all storage charges (previously suspended on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2021) will resume from 2<sup>nd</sup> August and have communicated the following:

Quote:

*“Import containers have been available for collection, using the Navis customer links to assign transporters since 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021. Coega NCT and Port Elizabeth PECT have begun releasing using Navis customer links from 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021. Therefore, the change-over from free storage will be managed as follows:*

- *The free storage days will only be given for vessels who have completed discharge after 00h01 on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021.*
- *For all other vessels which have completed discharge prior to this date the free days shall be considered as utilised before 00h01 on Monday 2 August 2021.*

*Further terminal specific extensions may be granted on a terminal basis - these will be communicated by the terminal if they require any further extensions.”*

Please find below the status of affected ONE services & vessels:

### Capetown

- SAS service - M/V NYK Fuji - Vessel sailed 1<sup>st</sup> August 2021.
- SAS service - M/V Brottone Bridge - Vessel expected to berth 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2021 with departure currently planned for 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
- SRX service - M/V Santa Clara - Vessel under operations and departure expected 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2021 AM.
- SRX service - M/V Maira XL - Vessel still at anchorage. Based on latest berth planning the vessel will be able to berth on 4<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Departure currently planned for 7<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
- SRX service - DAL Kalahari - Vessel arrival planned for 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Departure planned for 7<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
- AIM service - M/V NYK Paula - Vessel berthed 1<sup>st</sup> August 2021 and departure is expected on 2<sup>nd</sup> August late PM.

### **Coega /Port Elizabeth**

- SRX service - M/V Santa Isabel was able to berth on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2021 and is current operating at the Coega NCT terminal. Departure is scheduled for 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2021 AM.
- SRX service - M/V Santa Ursula is schedule to arrive at Coega NCT 4<sup>th</sup> August 2021 and depart 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021.

### **Durban**

- SAC service - M/V Ever United - Vessel is under operations at Durban. Departure scheduled for 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2021 PM.
- SAC service - M/V MOL Earnest - Vessel is expected to arrive on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021. and berth on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Departure is planned for 10<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
- SAS service - M/V Ever Devote - Vessel is alongside at Durban. Departure is planned for 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
- SAS service - M/V Kota Legit - Vessel is at anchorage at Durban. Berthing of the vessel is planned for 5<sup>th</sup> August 201.
- SAS service - M/V Kota Lawa - Vessel is expected to arrive at Durban today 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2021. Berthing timing and expected departure timing still to be advised.
